## Catalina Foothills High School Mission Statement

The mission of Catalina Foothills High School is to ensure that each student demonstrates outstanding academic and personal achievement, graduates, and becomes a contributing member of the global community by engaging students in meaningful and challenging learning experiences within an environment that fosters a passion for learning and personal behavior of the highest standards.

## School and Community

Catalina Foothills High School is located in the shadow of the Santa Catalina Mountains on Tucson's north side. CFHS is accredited by the North Central Association and graduated its first class in 1996. While the community has become increasingly diverse, most families are headed by college-educated professionals who value education, expect excellence, and provide a great deal of support to their students and to the school. This public high school, operating on a semester system, has a student population of approximately 1850 students in grades 9 through 12. Over 60% of CFHS faculty and administration hold advanced degrees.

Students must earn 24 credits for graduation:

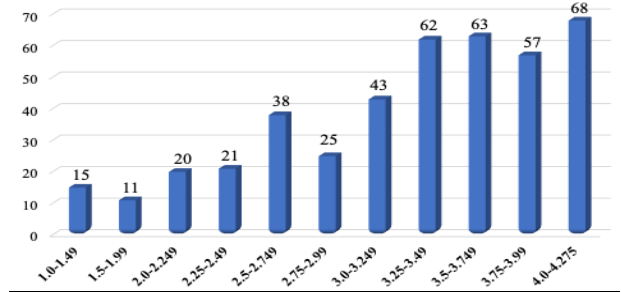

### COVID-19 Addendum

CFHS pivoted to remote learning in April 2020 due to COVID-19 precautions. School continued 100% remote learning August 2020 but moved to hybrid in November. In spring, students were given a choice of being 100% in person or 100% remote (teacher addressing both in-class and remote students during each class period.) Teaching and learning continued and letter grades were awarded in May of 2020 as well as each semester of the 2020-21 school year. We are 100% in-person for fall of 2021 but continuing to follow CDC guidelines (masks, sanitation, no guests, etc.)

### Clubs & Organizations

CFHS provides a wide variety of student clubs and leadership opportunities, along with our art, music, and theatre programs, to complement academic life. These include Science Olympiad, Model UN, Chess Club, Mu Alpha Theta, Speech & Debate Team, DECA, HOSA, FFA, Skills USA, Link Crew, National Honor Society, Student Council, Yearbook, and Performing Arts. The CFHS band is the largest in the state with over 250 members and has performed in China, Australia, Hawaii, Disneyland, the Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade.

Falcon athletics include baseball, basketball, cheer, cross country, football, golf, soccer, softball, swimming and diving, tennis, track and field, volleyball, and wrestling.
